#### **BBC 500 Words Story Writing Competition**

Last week we had an assembly about the BBC 500 Words Competition which is a story writing competition open to 5 – 11 year olds. The children seemed excited to take part and we are looking forward to receiving their entries. The story must be no longer than 500 words and needs to be submitted in a digital format. Children can dictate their story for an adult to type up, but the story must be the children's **own** work. If children do not have access to a laptop, we will give them the opportunity to use the laptops at school. Entries need to be sent into school via email by **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November** to give us time to submit them by 8<sup>th</sup> November to the BBC. The entries are separated into two categories: 5-7 and 8-11. 
