We are delighted to announce that we have achieved the School Games GOLD Mark Award for the 2024/25 academic year.

The School Games Mark is a Government-led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success.

With a huge number of our young people competing in local inter-school competitions this year, we are extremely proud of our pupils for their dedication to all aspects of school sport, including those young volunteers, leaders and officials who made our competitions possible.

As part of our application, we were asked to fulfil criteria in the areas of participation, competition, workforce and clubs, and we are pleased that the hard work of everyone at our school has been rewarded this year.

Subject: 5-min survey - For every response £1 goes to our school

Our school is taking part in a national pilot run by the Department of Health and Social Care, working with the Department for Education. They have commissioned Verian (www.veriangroup.com), a research agency, to test the updated School Food Standards designed to make sure school meals are healthy, balanced, and enjoyable for children.

As part of the pilot, our school menu will change next term so that the updated standards can be tested in practice.

As part of the research, parents / carers will be invited to complete two short surveys (around 5 minutes each) together with your child - one before the changes to menus (in October) and one after (in November). All responses are anonymous and will only be used for research purposes.

Please take part by completing the first of the two 5-minute surveys with your child (the second will be sent in November). Each completed survey will bring £1 directly to our school, so by taking part, you'll be supporting both national change and helping us invest in the things that matter for our students.

Year 6 transferring to secondary school in September 2026 - Message from DCC

We are now over halfway through the application window for Secondary school admissions into Year 7 next September. We understand that parents and children are still visiting schools and

weighing up their options, but the closing date is looming. Within the admissions portal there is the facility to identify whether your Year 6 pupils have made their application for Secondary School.

The easiest way for these families to apply is online by visiting www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline If families don't wish to or can't apply online, they can also complete a hard copy application form which can be obtained by calling 0345 155 1019.

The closing date for applications is 31st October 2025.

A lot of secondary schools in Devon are under pressure with space due to local growth, so it is essential that we get as many applicants applying on-time as possible. Late applications may be disadvantaged, so it is vital parents make an on time application to give themselves the best chance of securing a place at one of their preferred schools.


