#### Pick up time on the field

We appreciate that it feels a little distanced to wait for your child on the half of the field nearest to the gate and we really don't want you to feel distanced – BUT it is really hard to match children to their adults when everyone crowds around. If you could get into a habit of waiting in the same spot each day and spreading yourselves out a bit, it makes it a lot easier to spot you and make sure you and your child are united safely and happily.

Once you have your child you can come to speak to staff if you need to let them know about something. We don't want you to feel that you can't approach staff just appreciate that our first priority is making sure the children all get home safely.

Please also remember to let us know if your child is going home with someone else as early in the day as possible, by email is easier or speak to a member of staff to pass on. Teachers can't check their emails when teaching but generally give them a quick scan at lunchtime with any messages from admin.



#### We are an allergy aware school

The approach advocated by Anaphylaxis UK is to not necessarily support a blanket ban on any particular allergen in any establishment, including in schools. This is because nuts, for example, are only one of many allergens that could affect pupils, and no school could guarantee a truly allergen free environment for a child living with food allergy. They advocate instead for schools to adopt a culture of allergy awareness and education.

A 'whole school awareness of allergies' is a much better approach, as it ensures teachers, pupils and all other staff are aware of what allergies are, the importance of avoiding the pupils' allergens, the signs & symptoms, how to deal with allergic reactions and to ensure policies and procedures are in place to minimise risk.

This means that children should not share food and if a member of the class has an airborne allergy then the teachers will let you know and it would be best practice for children to let staff know if they have any food items that contain this allergen so we can be extra careful.



#### The Grove School Cookery Book

We will be making our own Grove School cookbook this year with recipes from staff and hopefully from your homes too. If you could email me your favourite family dish as a recipe this would be amazing and we will credit it to you in the book. The more culturally diverse the recipes the better – but they do have to be something your children love to eat! We will also think about using them in our school meals menu. The children have also been supplied with a little worksheet to complete at home and return to school. This is a lovely fundraising project so it would great for you to support it if you can.


