#### What's been happening this week and next

The vaccination team will be here tomorrow morning administering the nasal Flu vaccination to all children that have consented through the link. On Monday some Year 5's will be taking part in the Bikeability course being held here. Level I is learning to ride a bike in a traffic-free environment (2 hour course) and Level 2 is learning to ride on quiet roads - passing parked cars, passing junctions, turns from major to minor roads and vice versa. The main focuses are on observation, road position, communication and knowing road priorities.


