## INFORMATION FOR YEAR 5 PARENTS 11+ EXAMINATION FOR ENTRY IN SEPTEMBER 2022

### Would you like your child to attend Churston Ferrers Grammar School?

If so, applications are now open to register your child to sit the 11+ examination at Churston Ferrers Grammar School. The examination date this year is Saturday 18th September 2021 (as long as no further COVID restrictions are put in place) and all children currently in Year 5 are eligible to sit the examination.

Following submission, you will receive an automatic reply to say that we have received the form and in the week preceding the examination we will send you an email with all the details you will need for your child on the exam date.
