Dear Parents and Carers,

Coming Soon - New system for ordering lunches

At the moment children order their lunches in the morning with the teacher but as from Monday 26th June we will be going live with a new pre-booking system called 'ParentPay'. Before the 26th (next week) you will receive more information on this system along with an email with your activation code. Lunches will need to be ordered by Thursday evenings the week before.

You can order and pay for the whole term in advance if this is easier for you. This is so we can accurately buy ingredients and have less waste in the kitchen but also have less cash in school. If you can't pay online, then please let us know and we can help.

Once you have activated your account you can log in. The menu will be on this platform. For all children in Reception, Years I and 2 there is no charge but children in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 meals must be paid online for in advance. All children including Reception, Year I, 2 and those who qualify for FSM must pre-order. Some of you may already use this system with other children you have at secondary schools. We haven't used this system before so please be patient with us while we adapt!!

Year I and 2 to the Box Museum tomorrow

Tomorrow all children in Lime, Chestnut and Dove tree class will be going on their trip to the Box in Plymouth, linking to their Art learning this term. They will be taking part in an art workshop and having a guided gallery tour, where they can focus in on curriculum areas we have been learning about. All the activities will be run by skilled learning facilitators. Please could all children bring a drink, snack and packed lunch (unless you have pre ordered a school packed lunch) in a back pack please. The coach is due to depart shortly after 9 so please could everyone be on time. Thank you.


