At our latest governing board meeting yesterday we reflected on the school's attendance figures. These have been consistently above 95% for the last five years which is excellent. The latest data for this term is 95.6%. Nationally, school attendance is still below pre-pandemic levels, and many schools are struggling with whole school attendance levels of 80-85%.

Our attendance record reflects a strong partnership between families and the school, and showcases the engaging and inspiring learning environment created by our staff that children enjoy being in. This is something that we should be incredibly proud of.

There will always be challenges to face when it comes to achieving the best possible attendance, and I would like to recognise the commitment and support that is shown by families and staff throughout the year to manage this sensitively and proactively.
