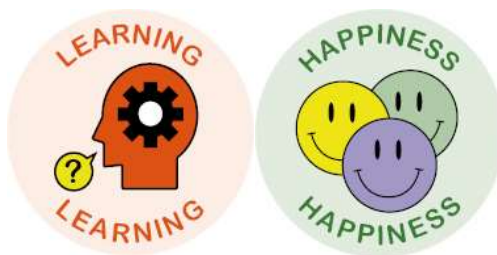
Tempest Photography
