Totnes Foodbank

Here at school we work closely with the Foodbank. We know locally that many more families are finding things difficult at the moment than would normally be the case. The foodbank have extended their referral criteria to include families who are struggling financially because of Covid 19. Deliveries are on Thursdays and Fridays, will be dropped at your door and there will be no physical contact with the driver. The boxes contain mainly dried and tinned foods, some toiletries and nappies if needed. There could also be some fresh produce, which is donated by Food in the Community. The Foodbank is being very well supported by the local community including Morrisons who are currently donating £1,500 of food a week. There is capacity for more referrals.
