

Potential pre-school at The Grove!!

As a school we are always looking for ways to serve our community and it's needs. We have had discussions with local nursery providers and Devon County Council and we can see there is a need for more provision for younger children in Totnes. We are in the early stages of seeing whether running a term-time only, school day based class for those 3 and 4 year olds who will start school next September 2026 would be of interest. Parents could use their nursery funding and private funding for either 15 hours or 30 hours a week. We could potentially start this class from September 2025. We are also investigating using the school for holiday clubs as again there is a real need in Totnes, but will get back to you on this.

Churston Ferrers Grammar School has updated its admissions policy for September 2026

The admissions policy change addresses the issue of students from increasingly distant areas (90 minute + journey times) securing places at the expense of qualified students from the school's more immediate locality.

The new policy prioritises:

- Looked after children, previously looked after children, and those with EHCPs naming Churston
- The top 50 highest-scoring students, regardless of location or primary school attended.
- Students eligible for Free School Meals, Pupil Premium, or Service Pupil Premium; those with siblings already at Churston; children of staff; and students from 15 designated local feeder schools in Torbay.
- Remaining places are allocated based on 11+ score rank order.

This aims to balance local access with merit-based admissions. While approximately 20 more local, qualified students will gain places who would have previously missed out on a purely rank-ordered allocation, ten additional Year 7 places have been created to minimize the impact on overall admission chances. Essentially, for families at The Grove, the situation remains the same: students take the 11+ and are ranked by score, with the majority of places at Churston being awarded based on the child's place in the rank order.

The next Open Day event at Churston is on Thursday 26 June - there are tours of the school during the day and into the evening.
