#### The Grove School makes top rankings in South West

Read this clip with the understanding there are 20,751 state primary schools in England, 2,319 in the South West and 416 in Devon.

This means The Grove is in the top 1.4% in England in terms of outcomes for children, 0.3% in the South West and ranked 2nd in Devon:

'Two Devon schools have also made it into the top primary schools in the south west state only. Wilcombe Primary School in Tiverton, is ranked 4th with a national ranking of 65th. The Grove School in Totnes is in 8th position with a national ranking of 299th.'
