Our 2025 SATS results

Our children continue to achieve very well at The Grove and we are very proud of their attitude and pride in their learning.

EYFS (Reception) achieved 'Early learning goals with a good level of development' in all prime areas 86% (National for 2024 62%)

YI phonics 82% (National 81%)

Y4 Timetables Average score out of 25 is 20.6, (National 2024 20.6) 48% of children were high scorers of 23+

KS2 Y6 SATS

Reading 94% working at expected level (National 75%), 60% working at Greater Depth, Average point score 108

Spelling and Grammar 90% working at expected level (National 73%), 35% working at Greater Depth, Average point score 106

Maths 94% working at expected level (National 74%), 46% working at Greater Depth, Average point score 108

Writing 90% working at expected level (National 72%), 27% working at Greater Depth

Science 92% working at expected level (National 82%)

Reading writing and Maths achieving all 3 at expected 85% (national 62%), and at Greater Depth 23%

We traditionally do not have a mufti on the last day of the summer term as the Y6's like to have their shirts signed and wear their uniform for the last day. We will be sad to see this incredible Y6 leave us, they truly have been wonderful, so respectful of each other and the school.

The Children's Kitchen

Food is very important to us at the Grove, and we were delighted to win the Excellence in School Food award in January 2024. We are proud to work with Chefs in Schools, and to employ a professional chef who not only produces delicious, freshly cooked food using local ingredients where possible, but has also worked with us to develop a cooking curriculum so that children learn to try different tastes, understand where food comes from, and develop cookery skills from an early age. We think food is essential for children's behaviour, health, and wellbeing.

If you would like your child to have school meals at the Grove, children in Reception, Years I and 2 are all eligible for free school meals, we just ask you to sit down with your child and order their meals in advance, using Parentpay. This is important for us in reducing food waste and in making the kitchen run economically.

For children in Year 3 and up, there is a cost of £2.75 per meal, also ordered and paid for in advance on Parentpay. Please note that this is a slight increase in cost from last year- we have done our best to keep costs as low as possible whilst making sure that the meals are balanced, nutritious, and exciting!

If you have any feedback or thoughts about the kitchen, we'd love to hear from you.

Dates for September.

Term starts on Wednesday 3rd September for children. Staff will be in school the day before for training and preparation.

Meet the teacher – Monday September 8th from 3:30pm – this is a chance to see how your child has settled, understand the new routines and ask the teacher any questions about the new class etc.

Meal time assistant to help in the dining hall 11:30-1:30 daily

We are seeking a new meal time assistant to help set the tables and chairs out with the children and classroom staff daily and then put them away, help with the serving and clearing of meals and the children's meal time needs. You would join a lovely kitchen team and classroom staff always accompany their children in the hall for lunch and encourage mealtime conversations, good manners and a tidy up after the sitting from the children. 
