Pupil Premium and Free School Meals - Please check

Some children are entitled to pupil premium funding and Free School Meals from the government which helps pay for support for your child in the classroom. For Reception children this money pays for some I-I support from a member of our team for any specific needs. For older children we also use this to provide some I-I support but

can also use it to support the child in a wider sense. Educational need is the priority but we can also support music lessons, sports clubs and activities etc.

A child is entitled to pupil premium if their family is on a low income and entitled to 'free school meals' or if they are adopted or in care (looked after full time by another member of the family can sometimes fall under this category).

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Please see the school office if you think this may be something you can apply for – it can really help your child's education. It is worth noting that if a family is out of work even just for a short amount of time and would qualify for this it is still worth applying because the child gets the money allocated for the next 6 years even if you go back to work.

Year 6 transferring to secondary school in September 2024 - Message from DCC

The deadline to make your application to the Local Authority is the 31st October 2023. You can apply online by visiting www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline Please be advised that if you don't apply or apply after the closing date of the 31st October 2023, your application will be considered after all timely applications, and this may mean that you miss out on a place at your preferred or local school. Places are not held in reserve for people that apply late. It is important that you make your application before the closing date to give your child the best chance of getting a place at one of your preferred schools. Please don't assume you don't need to apply and that you will be allocated a place at the local secondary school if you don't. You must make an application and give the Local Authority your preferences. If you don't tell the admissions team where you want your child to go to school, you will run the risk of being allocated a place at a school that isn't the nearest school, or a preferred school, and it may also be a school to which you are unable to transport your child to.
