What's happening this week and next

Tomorrow children will be having their nasal flu vaccination if you consented. This Friday is Mufti day. The theme is Halloween/Autumn for a donation of sweets for the Christmas PTA fair. Next week Year 5 and 6 will be going on a trip to Plymouth University to take part in a literacy workshop and then have a guided tour of the University campus. The literacy workshop is being run by David Lawrence Jones (author of the Bradley Baker series of children's books) and will be about creating a new adventure to a magical place. The campus tour will give an insight into life at the University.

Books That Help Project
