Year 6 moving transferring Secondary School applications

Please apply for a secondary school place before the 31st October. The easiest way for families to apply is online by visiting www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline If families don't wish to or can't apply online, they can also complete a hard copy application form which we have attached to this email for them to complete. We would prefer it if the forms were scanned and emailed into us at admissions@devon.gov.uk as we are still not in the office. We are entering into a period now where a lot of secondary schools in Devon will be experiencing growth, so it is essential that we get as many applicants applying on-time. Late applications may be disadvantaged, so it is essential they make an on time application to give themselves the best chance of securing a place at one of their preferred schools. Please note that children with EHCP's have been invited to apply through the admissions team this year and they should complete the form or apply online for their preferences which can include specialist or independent settings if they wish. Lastly, we are running a campaign on social media to try to ensure everyone applies before the closing date, therefore we would appreciate it if you could share any Social Media posts that you see from our Facebook account relating to this campaign. In addition to this, if you are able to text any of your year 6 families and include something in your newsletter this would be really helpful.
